Conditions of Membership

1. It is not possible to allow persons to have access to firearms and ammunition or to the range unless they are:
 - a. **Full Members or Probationary Members of this club.**
 - b. **In possession of a current personal Firearms Certificate.**
 - c. **Full members of another club.**

There is a six months Probationary Membership period required under club rules for new members who do not already possess a Firearm Certificate. These regulations are part of the approval criteria for Rifle and Pistol Clubs. During this first six months period, probationary members are expected to attend the range for practice on at least **TWELVE** occasions.

On completion of the six months probationary membership and a minimum of 12 range visits during this time, full membership may be granted at the absolute discretion of the committee whose decision shall be final and is not subject to any possible appeal in any circumstances. Members who are in possession of a personal Firearm Certificate must attend the range for practice during the membership year and record details of their Firearms use in the personal attendance log at the range. Failure to do this could result in a refusal by the Firearms Registry to renew their certificate.

They are also expected to take part in any Club competitions.

2. At present the Club caters for:
Air weapons, Pistol calibre carbine and sporting small bore rifle using ammunition up to range limits on:
Tuesday – from 7:30pm / Wednesday – from 7:00pm / Friday – from 7:30pm – all the above and Black Powder Pistol
2nd Sunday of the month – outdoor shooting at Altcar Ranges (200 / 300 yds+) regardless of weather conditions

3. The Probationary Membership Fees for the membership year listed at the club and on downloads at http://www.prestonshooters.org.uk/downloads/club_documents/pdf/club_pricelist.pdf (Probationary membership lasts 1 months + 5 months =6 months total.)
4. It is an offence for someone who is prohibited by section 21 of the Firearms Act to have a Firearm or ammunition in their possession at any time. Section 21 applies to anyone who has been sentenced to imprisonment or to youth custody or detention in a young offenders institution for three months or more. If the sentence was for longer than three years the prohibition is for life, between three months and three years the prohibition lasts for five years. It is an offence for someone to give, lend, transfer or hire a firearm / ammunition to someone whom he/she has reasonable grounds for believing to be prohibited by section 21. Although air weapons are not generally covered by certification procedures, the prohibitions do extend to **all** firearms.
5. Persons chosen by you as referees must be either:-
 - a. Two Full Members of the Club.
 - b. One Full Member of this Shooting Club who is a Firearm Certificate Holder.
 - c. One other personal reference in writing.(excluding family members or friends)

The personal reference must satisfy the same conditions of the persons authorised to counter / sign a Firearms Application i.e. persons who would be qualified to countersign a Passport Application. These referees must be satisfied there is no reason why you should not have access to firearms and ammunition. It is a club rule that all members attend the range at least 12 times per year. Failure to comply with this rule may result in membership renewals being refused.

This document should be read in conjunction with all the terms and conditions of the constitution of the club.

Juniors are defined in the constitution and must complete competency and supervision requirements

The Club will retain your information for longer than your membership when necessary to meet the requirements of the Club's Home Office approval, insurance and financial audit requirements.

NB The following data is required by law for Home Office Approved Clubs to operate and without granting permission to use this data, you cannot be a member of the Club:

Your full name, address, date of birth, place of birth, dates of attendance at the Club and firearms used on those dates, FAC No, Licensing authority and details of firearms held and used at the Club.
